Sir:

I have to inform you that the Department is approving of the appointment of Miss Helen Earl as teacher of the new school which is to be established for the benefit of the Indian children of the Campbell River Indian reserve. Miss Earl has had long experience as a teacher, under the direction of the Department and the Church. The school will be conducted under the auspices of the United Church of Canada, who nominated the services of Miss Earl.

At the present time, the Department is not aware when the school will be completed and ready for occupation, but Miss Earl will take charge when the classroom is ready. I would request that you give her every assistance you can in her work at this school. The salary allowed her will be at the rate of \$35.00 per teaching month.

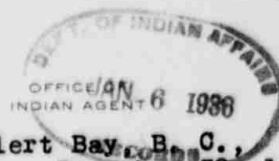

Representative of the Treasury.

The Department has approved the appointment of Miss Helen Earl as teacher of the new Campbell River Indian Day School, with salary at the rate of \$85 a teaching month. (Copy of Memo to Minister dated July 30th, 1935, also questionnaire, attached herewith).

In official letter of December 30th, 1935, Mr. Agent Todd advises that Miss Earl began duties on November 18th, 1935, and she is, therefore, entitled to 13/30 of salary for November (\$36.83); plus salary for December (\$85.00); and salary for January (\$85.00); or a total of \$206.83.

The following entry should appear on the payroll for the month of January:-

I desire to refer you to my memorandum of December 13, 1944, in which I advised you that Mrs. M.K. Waywell had resigned as teacher of the above-noted school.

The Department has approved the appointment of Mrs. R. E. Yeatman as teacher of this school, at a salary of \$100.00 a teaching month, plus bonus, effective January 1, 1945. I attach copy of letter to Indian Commissioner MacKay, approving her appointment.

I also attach Cost-of-Living Bonus Form, T.D.1 Form and War Savings Pledge, all completed by Mrs. Yeatman.
